

Plants for Taste:

Grow in greenhouse from seed and plant into tubs or tyres:

Chives, *Allium schoenoprasum*; in addition to delicious foliage that can be used in salads. This plant also produces pretty pink, mauve or purple flowers.

Nasturtium, *Tropaeolum majus*; a colourful salad can be made from the beautiful peppery orange, red or yellow flowers and the foliage.

Pot marigold, *Calendula officinalis*; gorgeous, sunny flowers, with aromatic, dark green leaves.

Sweet basil, *Ocimum basilicum*; fresh-tasting herb.

Buy plants in pots or donated clumps from gardens and grow in-situ:

Bronze Fennel

Rosemary, *Rosmarinus officinalis*; highly fragrant leaves.

Sage – *Salvia officinalis* / Sage Tricolor / Bronze Sage

Spearmint; *Mentha spicata*; Chocolate Mint; Strawberry Mint / Pineapple Mint / Apple Mint

Thyme

Wild strawberry, *Fragaria vesca*; this plant loves partial sun and fairly damp conditions and produces small, sweet, delicious fruit. X 6 – 10 plants

Plants for Smell:

Grow in greenhouse from seed and plant into tubs or tyres:

Antirrhinum – Snap Dragons

Chocolate cosmos, *Cosmos atrosanguineus*; beautiful, maroon flowers give off a chocolate/ vanilla scent.

Stocks, scented summer flowers.

Buy plants in pots or donated clumps from gardens and grow in-situ:

Artemisia; Wormwood, highly scented leaves, soft to touch and vigorous growing shrub.

Buddleia Cascade – Scented bushy shrub with long panicles of scented flowers.

Chamomile

Choisya Ternata 'Sundance' – Scented shrub with white flowers and golden leaves.

Curry plant, *Helichrysum italicum*; curry smelling leaves which give off a spicy aroma on a warm, sunny day.

Clematis Armandii, Apple Blossom – evergreen climber, highly scented in spring.

Itea virginica 'Henry's Garnet' – Deciduous shrub.

Jasmine – Trachelosepermum Jasminoides; evergreen scented climber for pergolas.

Lavender, Lavandula angustifolia; relaxing, fresh aroma with tiny purple flowers.

Lemon Bergamot / Monarda Citriodora – Mint like annual; base for Earl Grey tea

Lemon scented geranium, Pelargonium crispum; crinkly leaves that smell of lemon when rubbed.

Oregano/wild marjoram, Origanum vulgare; aromatic leaves.

Skimmia Japonica, early flowering evergreen shrub with highly scented flowers.

Plants for Sound:

Grow in greenhouse from seed and plant into tubs or tyres:

Sweetcorn – as it grows the leaves stand tall and rustle.

Buy plants in pots or donated clumps from gardens and grow in-situ:

Fargesia Volcano – Clumping Bamboo x 4

Miscanthus Sinensis – Grass x 3

Pampas Grass- Cortaderia selloana 'Pumila' – more compact variety x 1

Stipa Tenuissima – Pony tails

Plants for Sight:

Grow in greenhouse from seed and plant into tubs or tyres:

Shade loving annuals / wildflower seed packets or seed bombs to place around the edges
