## Sports Funding 2017-18

### **Sports Ambassadors play an active part in promoting school sport.**

- Sports ambassadors are positive role models and promote school sport in a variety of ways – website, assemblies, school notice board, newsletters etc.

*Sports Ambassadors are identified early in the year and co-ordinate with PE coordinator and coaches to ensure different sports are offered at lunchtimes. Aside from the training, this can all be completed within school.*

### **Forest Schools**

- Children to have access to Forest schooling to improve their physical development alongside other areas.

*A teacher has been employed to run the forest school.*

### **Competitions**

- Children attend competitions at local level and 2b of the school games.

*Sports Organiser employed to ensure that competitions are entered and supported which allows children to attend the majority of competitions organized by the school sports partnership.*
